☞ “After a short maternity leave, I would continue to work, and he would quit his job to take care of the baby.”

☞ This would not have happened in Shakespeare's England. Childcare was considered a feminine trait. The author is taking on the masculine role just like Lady Macbeth did in 1.7. 58-62.
